

LARC/SHOOKIE Day Camp ~ Important Information

Transportation

Transportation to and from camp is available by bus at no extra charge. Each bus is chaperoned by camp staff. If you wish to use this service, please indicate on the application which bus stop your child will be using. Please list only one stop. Please be advised that the buses are not wheelchair accessible. A detailed bus schedule is available on the back page. If you choose to drive your child to and from camp, you must check in at the office. Campers may not be dropped off earlier than 9:00 A.M. and must be picked up by 4:00 P.M. Campers may only be released from camp or the bus stop to people listed on the application form. **When picking up a camper, you will be asked to provide a photo ID of yourself.**

Lunch

Campers must bring a lunch, including a beverage each day. **Please pack all lunches in a plastic or paper bag** with the campers name and unit written on them. Please do not send coolers because refrigeration is provided at camp.

Refunds

Full Refund- Notification of cancellation is given at least two weeks prior to the start of the session.

Refund Less Deposit- Notification of cancellation is given one week prior to the start of the session.

50% Refund Less Deposit- Notification of cancellation is given 48 hours prior to the start of the session.

No refund will be given without a minimum of 48 hours notification of cancellation.

Medical Exception Refunds- When LARC is notified a camper cannot attend or finish a session due to an illness, a doctor's note MUST be received within one week of initial notification. A prorated refund will then be issued from the date of initial notification. LARC will not issue retroactive refunds when proper notification procedures are not followed.

Medical Forms

Medical Forms, mailed to you upon receipt of your registration, must be completed by the parent or guardian and a physician, or children will not be allowed to attend camp. This is in accordance with state laws and camping standards. Health forms are required **at least two weeks** prior to the beginning of the camp session. All campers must be examined by a physician within 36 months prior to the date of arrival at camp.

FROM TORRINGTON – Follow Route 4 heading west towards Goshen. Turn right onto University Drive at signs for University of Connecticut Higher Education Center. Take your second left onto Brandy Hill Rd. At the fork, bear right. Camp is at the top of the hill on the left. Look for the sign.

FROM WINSTED – Take Rt. 8 South to Torrington. Take exit 44 to Rt. 4 West heading towards Goshen. Follow directions from Torrington.
