
Building a Community for All

With the generosity of the community, we raised \$1.65 million during the project's first phase, and moved into our new building in 2009. The time is now to finish the building project by renovating the unfinished lower level.

Your support will enable us to create accessible space for students in our School to Community Transitions Program to learn essential life and vocational skills.

The project includes:

- Flexible, adaptable program space for immediate and long-term needs
- Fully equipped kitchen to teach life skills
- Handicapped accessible restrooms
- An elevator for accessibility
- Conference room and instructional office



In addition to allowing us to expand our school program, the new space will be used as a meeting room for our growing parent network and advocacy programs, providing additional benefits to our community.

School to Community Transition Program

Our vision of *Community for All*, led us to create a program to help 18-21 year olds successfully transition to adulthood.
