Interns in the program will complete three rotations at Charlotte Hungerford Hospital with the main goal of gaining the necessary skills to obtain competitive employment.

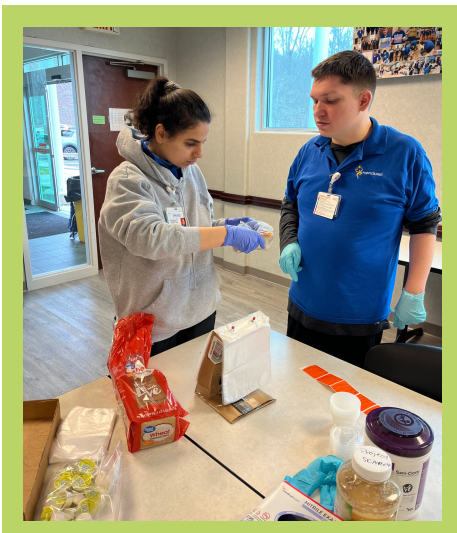


Where does the program take place?

- Reside in Northwestern Connecticut and have access to reliable transportation
- In the process of completing or have already completed a high school education
- Receiving DDS funding for employment services and/or have an IEP
