

**YOUR RIGHTS UNDER  
TITLE VI  
OF THE CIVIL RIGHTS ACT OF 1964**

Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, prohibits discrimination on the basis of race, color, national origin, sex, age or disability in programs, activities and services receiving federal financial assistance (42 U.S.C. Section 2000d).

**PROTECTIONS INCLUDE BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO: PUBLIC WAITING AREAS, PASSENGER HOLDING AREAS, SERVICE, QUALITY OF SERVICE, ROUTING, SCHEDULING, SNACK BARS, GIFT SHOPS, TICKET COUNTERS, BAGGAGE HANDLERS, CAR RENTAL AGENCIES, TAXIS, RESTAURANT FACILITIES, RESTROOMS, AND PASSENGER GROUND TRANSPORTATION.**

Any person who believes that he or she, has been subjected to discrimination prohibited under Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, may file a discrimination complaint.
